- Normalization is an idea of thinking to guarantee life and the right of the person with a disability, and it is put forward by Bank-Mikkelesen in Denmark in the 1950's. This idea was a thought to fix the condition to make people with disabilities have a normal life in the general public with the ordinary people by not having special supports.
- The first concept of universal design was born in the <u>United States</u>. The government had established <u>The ADA method</u> and did a hard work, but was not going well. Thereupon, <u>Dr. Ronald</u> had thought of the thought of "UD".
- The concept of UD had spread in Japan in about the 1980s. The <u>E&C Project</u> in 1991 had made the ideas of <u>items and services for a common use</u> in Japan. Laws and ordinances were made by the government, and one example is the <u>new-barrier free law</u> which was made in 2006.
